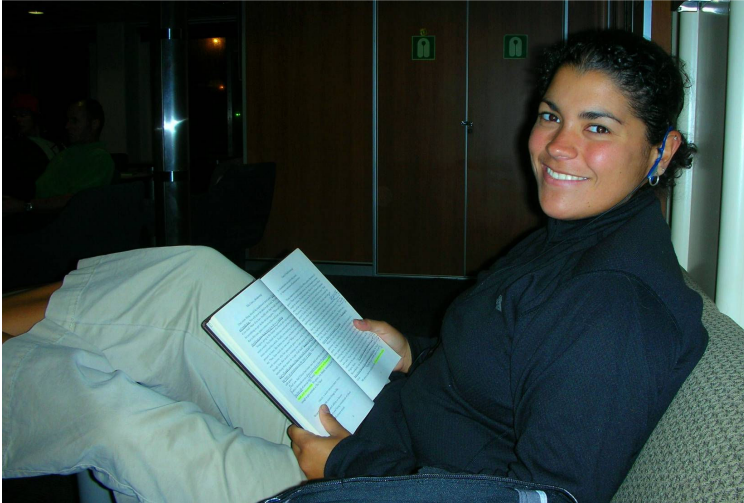


Diana Sierra, LMSW
